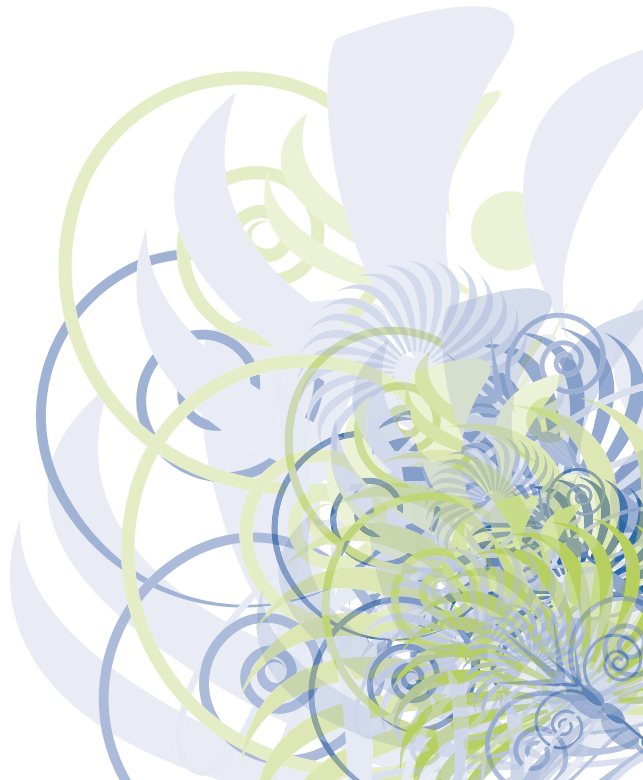

V1 INTERNAL VERIFIER AWARD

Conduct Internal Quality Assurance of the Assessment Process Awarding Body: OCR

Programme Aims

The programme provides training and assessment leading to the above Level 4 Single Unit Award. This unit is taken from the Learning & Development National Occupational Standards. It is designed as a stand-alone unit, but can be combined with other units to make up a Level 4 NVQ.

Programme Delivery

Initial assessment is conducted to establish the candidate's individual needs within their job role. Candidates will attend 3 workshops to discuss the requirements of the award. Candidates will then be assessed by observation while giving feedback to their Assessor candidate. In addition, candidates will produce a portfolio of evidence and will engage in professional discussion with their assessor.

The Unit requires candidates to conduct internal quality assurance of the assessment process by:

- Carrying out and evaluating internal assessment and quality assurance systems
- Supporting assessors
- Monitoring the quality of assessors' performance
- Meeting external quality assurance requirements

Assessment and Accreditation

Assessment will include work-based observations, professional discussion, questioning of the candidate, witness testimony and product evidence. Completed work is placed in a portfolio. The portfolios are moderated before the qualification can be awarded.

Progression

This unit is also an Optional unit in the Level 4 Learning & Development Award. On completion of the whole Level 4, candidates can progress onto the Level 5 in Learning & Development.

Entry Requirements

Candidates must hold the A1 Assessor Award in order to undertake the V1 Award and must have held this for 12 months.

The candidate needs to be actively involved in supporting assessors and participating in the internal and external quality assurance procedures.
